## FactSet - CRSP Linking Table by WRDS

FactSet - CRSP linking table provides the historical matching between various FactSet Identifiers and CRSP **PERMNO/PERMCO**.

#### **Linking Procedures**

FactSet maintains various identifiers across the products. **FSYM\_ID** is the most fundamental one that is used across the FactSet products, such as FactSet Fundamental and Lionshares. FSYM\_ID is associated with a security, and there are three types of FSYM\_ID, Security, Regional, and Listing.

The historical mapping is established between **FSYM\_ID** (Security, Regional, and Listing) and **PERMNO** via public identifiers (CUSIP, TICKER). In addition, **FACTSET\_Entity\_ID** is included in the linking table for firm-level linkages with **PERMCO**.

Also, the legacy id, **FS\_PERM\_SEC\_ID** is included in the table for users who want to use legacy data or some current products that are still using legacy id instead of **FSYM\_ID**.

Linking is done based on 8-digit historical CUSIP and stock ticker symbols. Linkages are established with **CUSIP** matching. **Ticker**-based matching also add a few more linkages.

Because there are several different date ranges (between **CUSIP** and **FSYM\_ID**, between **CUSIP** and **PERMNO**, between **FSYM\_ID** and **FACTSET\_ENTITY\_ID**), we choose the **link\_bdate** and **link\_edate** with a conservative method. Only the commonly overlapped period among the date ranges are chosen to be the effective link period.

**WRDS FactSet - CRSP Linking Table** is provided to users who subscribe *CRSP* and either *FactSet Fundamental* or *Lionshares*. It will be updated annually.

#### **Notes**

We add FSYM\_ID\_KIND variable as an FSYM\_ID type variable since *FactSet* uses different types of FSYM\_ID in each product but with the same variable name, 'FSYM\_ID'.

The FSYM\_ID\_KIND variable helps to resolve an issue that often users are not able to note which type of FSYM\_ID is being used without reading the data manual. Users can filter the linking table by choosing the type of FSYM\_ID in need before merging it to other *FactSet* products.

For the security FSYM\_ID, the value of FSYM\_ID\_KIND is "S", for the regional FSYM\_ID, the value is "R", and for the listing FSYM\_ID, the value is "L". This follows the *FactSet*'s rule that security FSYM\_ID ends with "S", regional FSYM\_ID ends with "R", and listing FSYM\_ID ends with "L".

#### Security FSYM\_ID

When utilizing the complex linkages across FSYM\_ID, FACTSET\_Entity\_ID, PERMNO, and PERMCO, users should choose FSYM\_ID\_KIND = "S" to have uniquely identified linkages because the linking between FACTSET\_ENTITY\_ID and FSYM\_ID is established based on security FSYM\_ID.

#### Regional FSYM\_ID

FactSet Fundamental uses **regional FSYM\_ID**. Occasionally, **security FSYM\_ID** is also used. Users can keep only "R" and "S" type linkages and use them to merge FactSet Fundamental with CRSP.

### Listing FSYM\_ID

The listing FSYM\_ID is used to identify active/inactive security listings. The listing FSYM\_ID always ends with 'L'. Therefore, if the *FactSet* data table you are working on has FSYM\_ID ending with 'L', you need to choose **FSYM\_ID\_KIND = "L"** in order to link the *FactSet* data with CRSP data.

As briefly mentioned in the beginning, in *FactSet*'s legacy data, the unique security-level identifier is not **FSYM\_ID** but **FS\_PERM\_SEC\_ID**. In addition, some of the datasets in the current version of *FactSet* still have **FS\_PERM\_SEC\_ID** as a unique security-level identifier.

#### FS\_PERM\_SEC\_ID

FactSet Fundamental's price data keep FS\_PERM\_SEC\_ID instead of new FSYM\_ID. Also, the h\_security series in FactSet Common library also keep FS\_PERM\_SEC\_ID. In this linking table, we integrate the mapping between FSYM\_ID and FS\_PERM\_SEC\_ID for CRSP securities (North America) for our users' convenience. If you want to have the entire mapping between FSYM\_ID and FS\_PERM\_SEC\_ID, you can use sym\_legacy\_perm\_id.sas7bdat located in /wrds/factset/sasdata/common/

#### **Data Items**

For more detailed definition of the variables, please refer to FactSet manuals and CRSP manual.

Variable	Description
FSYM_ID	A unique FactSet identifier assigned to a security (v3)
FSYM_ID_KIND	Type of FSYM_ID. S represents Security, R represents Regional, L represents Listing
PROPER_NAME	Name of the security associated with the identifier
FSYM_REGIONAL_ID	A Regional-level <i>FactSet</i> identifier
FSYM_SECURITY_ID	A Security-level <i>FactSet</i> identifier
FS_PERM_SEC_ID	Legacy security id still being kept in several data tables
FACTSET_ENTITY_ID	Unique FactSet identifier representing an entity
ENTITY_PROPER_NAME	Name that the entity is commonly referred to as, normalized and in proper case
cusip_fs	9-digit CUSIP number retained in <i>FactSet</i>
TICKER_EXCHANGE	FactSet ticker symbol appended with exchange code. This is a HEADER variable, not historical.
PERMNO	CRSP Permanent Number

PERMCO	CRSP Permanent Company Number
CUSIP	CRSP Header CUSIP Number
NCUSIP	CRSP Historical CUSIP Number
TICKER	CRSP Historical Ticker Symbol
COMNAM	CRSP Historical Company Name
link_bdate	Effective link start date
link_edate	Effective link end date
